What is Live Scan Fingerprinting?

Live Scan is a system used for the electronic submission of applicant fingerprints to the Department of Justice (DOJ). Live Scan is a computer digitized fingerprinting that replaces the process of recording fingerprint patterns through a rolling process using ink. This system allows for the electronic transfer of fingerprint image data to DOJ in a matter of seconds, instead of the days required to send print card through the mail. This system also allows for the results to be received within days, versus seven to ten weeks required for a print card.

Who needs Live Scan?

What do I need to bring with me to my appointment?

- ❖ "Request for Live Scan Service" form.
- ❖ Please make sure you have completed it prior to your appointment.
- ❖ Payment for the Live Scan Fingerprinting Rolling fee and DoJ/FBI fee (Cash or Check Payable to "Live Scan Fingerprinting Plus" or Credit Card).
- ❖ Your Valid photographic Identification.

Examples of current and valid photographic identification include:

- ❖ California Driver License
- ❖ California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Identification Card
- ❖ Out-of-State Driver License
- ❖ Passport
- ❖ Alien Registration Card/Immigration/Green Card
- ❖ Military Identification Card

DoJ 24-hour Automated Telephone Service Available: 916-227-4557. If a requesting agency does not have results yet and digital Live Scan fingerprints were submitted, you can use the automated telephone system to check on your submission. You will need the following information: (1) your date of birth; and (2) the 10-digit Automated Transaction Identifier (ATI) number that appears at the bottom of the Department of Justice form requesting Live Scan fingerprint background checks. The ATI number always appears in the following sequence: 1 LETTER; 3 NUMBERS; 3 LETTERS and 3 NUMBERS.
